## Extreme Esthetics for Single Tooth Restorations

This comprehensive porcelain course will define and illustrate techniques that help the ceramist create consistent, natural looking porcelain restorations. The attendee will discover specific ways to achieve life-like esthetic results and overcome problems encountered at the laboratory bench. Simplified build-up techniques will be detailed using esthetic porcelain materials and accompanying effect porcelains. A brief explanation of how to maximize photography into your daily layering strategy will also be discussed. Each participant will construct one highly esthetic Central all ceramic crown.

Additional topics include:

- Soft Tissue Construction.
- Shade replication straight from the porcelain bottle.
- Shade communication: A Dentist-Patient-Lab team approach.
- Cervical & incisal esthetic tips; including the use of margin porcelains.
- Creating 3-dimensional effects with Opal, Pearl, Interno and Akzent colors.
- Surface texture and gloss control to duplicate natural tooth enamel finish.
- Instruction on Tooth Shape and Contouring.
